1.Stop work	All staff and contractors in affected area	 Cease work activities which may disturb material Don PPE before commencing any further activities.
2. Restrict Disturbance of Material	Atkin Building Co personnel	 erect warning tape directly around the area containing the suspect material: or, AND install temporary signage identifying asbestos present in area.
3 Report Incident	Atkin Building Co personnel	Report incident to property site supervisor and NTWorkSafe
4. Assess Risk	Approved licensed ACM Atkin Building Co personnel	Atkin Building Co personnel will arrange a risk assessment and provide to NTWorkSafe.
5. Implement Control Measures	Atkin Building Co personnel	 The ACM is to be cleaned up, packaged ready for removal by an EPA licensed collector and transporter of asbestos. A clearance certificate provided for the affected area at the completion of the clean-up.
6. Incident Report	Approved licensed ACM Atkin Building Co personnel	An incident report to be completed by the involved personnel and lodged with Atkin Building Co office, NTWorkSafe and the EPA.

1.Stop vehicle	Vehicle driver	 Stop and park the vehicle in a safe manner Don PPE before commencing any further activities Place incident cones to warn other traffic of a hazard.
2. Restrict Disturbance of Material	Vehicle driver	 erect warning tape directly around the area containing the suspect material: or, install temporary signage identifying asbestos present in area.
3. Report Incident	Vehicle driver	Report incident to NT Fire and Emergency Services, ACM supervisor and NTWorkSafe
4. Assess Risk	Approved licensed ACM Atkin Building Co personnel	Atkin Building Co personnel will arrange a risk assessment and provide to personnel involved in the clean-up and NTWorkSafe.
5. Implement Control Measures	Vehicle driver Approved licensed ACM Atkin Building Co personnel	 The ACM is to be cleaned up by a licensed asbestos removalist, packaged ready for removal by an EPA licensed collector and transporter of asbestos. A clearance certificate provided for the affected area at the completion of the clean-up.
6. Incident Report	Vehicle driver Approved licensed ACM Atkin Building Co personnel	An incident report to be completed by the involved personnel and lodged with Atkin Building Co office, NTWorkSafe and the EPA.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

• Call medical emergency phone number:

Ambulance

Provide the following information:

- a. Nature of medical emergency,
- b. Location of the emergency (address, building, room number), and
- c. Your name and phone number from which you are calling.
- Do not move victim unless absolutely necessary.
- If personnel trained in First Aid are not available, as a minimum, attempt to provide the following assistance:
 - 1. Stop the bleeding with firm pressure on the wounds (note: avoid contact with blood or other bodily fluids).
 - 2. Clear the air passages using the Heimlich Maneuver in case of choking.
- Wear the appropriate personal protective equipment. Attempt first aid ONLY if trained and qualified.

FIRE EMERGENCY

- If the fire alarm is not available, notify the site personnel about the fire emergency by the following means (check applicable):

Telephone Voice Communication

Fight the fire ONLY if:

- The Fire Department has been notified.
- The fire is small and is not spreading to other areas.
- Escaping the area is possible by backing up to the nearest exit.
- The fire extinguisher is in working condition and personnel are trained to use it.
