Incident:	Leachate breakout identified high up on the western batter on stage 5.

<p>(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution</p>	<p>Some decolourisations to the batter has been observed in two spots in close proximity.</p> 
<p>(b) the place where the incident occurred</p>	<p>South west end of stage 5 western batter.</p>
<p>(c) the date and time of the incident</p>	<p>9.30 am 2nd February 2022</p>
<p>(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur</p>	<p>Wet condition saturating the batter as well as elevated leachate levels inside stage 5 allowing leachate to escape.</p>
<p>(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident</p>	<p>At this point in time due to the wet conditions machine intervention capping the leak is not possible. Absorbent silt sausages will be pegged below the breakout to prevent free leachate migration down the batter.</p>
