## The Draft Terms of Reference for an EIS - Southern Lease Mining Project, NT

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Draft Terms of Reference for an EIS – Southern Lease Mining Project, NT (the proposal).

The proposal was referred to the department as EPBC referral 2023/09457. The proposal was determined to be a controlled action on 4 May 2023, due to likely significant impacts on the following Matters of National Environmental Significance protected under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act):

- Listed threatened species and communities (sections 18 & 18A)
- Listed migratory species (sections 20 & 20A)

On 28 April 2023, the department paused the assessment approach decision clock to request confirmation as to whether the proposal requires environmental impact assessment under the *Environmental Protection Act 2019* (NT) and, if so, confirmation of whether the bilateral assessment will apply.

The department has reviewed the Proponent Initiated Environmental Impact Statement (PIEIS) Referral, Statement of Reasons and draft Terms of Reference (ToR) for an EIS document and provided comments at <a href="Attachment A">Attachment A</a>. The department is generally satisfied that, with the incorporation of the comments at <a href="Attachment A">Attachment A</a>, the ToR meets the requirements of Schedule 4 of the <a href="Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Regulations 2000">2000</a>, which details the matters required to be addressed by environmental impact statements. The department agrees that an EIS is an appropriate level of assessment, as multiple protected matters have potential to be significantly impacted, and the proposed action is a high-impact activity in an area of high ecological value.


