**THE IDENTITY OF THE PERSON NOTIFYING OF THE INCIDENT –**

**THE INCIDENT CAUSING OR THREATENING TO CAUSE POLLUTION –**

A 1000 litre drum containing 600 litre of bitumen emulsion had been discovered on its side with emulsion spilling from it down the loading ramp.

**THE PLACE WHERE THE INCIDENT OCCURRED –**

Maningrida Barge Landing.

**THE DATE AND TIME OF THE INCIDENT –**

10/09/2012 discovered around 4pm

**HOW THE POLLUTION OCCURRED, IS OCCURRING OR MAY OCCUR –**

Spill of product from container

**THE ATTEMPTS MADE TO PREVENT, REDUCE, CONTROL, RECTIFY OR CLEAN UP THE POLLUTION OR RESULTANT ENVIRONMENTAL HARM CAUSED OR THREATENING TO BE CAUSED BY THE INCIDENT –**

Immediate action was taken to control the flow and contain the remaining spill with a barrier of sand. Congealed emulsion was picked up by shovel and front end loader bucket. Emulsion which had settled on the beach was raked and picked up. With nightfall the cleanup was halted, continuing the following morning. Spillage reissue and barrier sand has been collected and binned for return and disposal. Review of the spill area will continue until clearance has been obtained. Environmental Audit provided has been contacted and will visit the site on Thursday 13 September. Maningrida GBM has visited the site and is happy with the cleanup response.
