Avoidance Area 5, 20 & 24

- 4. No works are permitted within Avoidance Area.
- Works to be restricted to maintenance of the existing carriageway (including 5. bridges), table drains and outlet drains only.

No damage to mature trees within the avoidance area. 6.

Avoidance Area 10

- Works are to be restricted to maintenance of the existing carriageway (including the bridge), table drains and outlet drains only.
- No damage to mature trees along the course of the creek, particulary the Boab tree 8. immediately west of the bridge on the southern bank of the creek and the white gum tree immediately west of the bridge on the northern side of the creek bed.
