

## NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

In relation to the notice to carry out an environmental audit program issued to *Voyages Indigenous Tourism Australia Pty Ltd* on 14 December 2021 pursuant to section 48 of the *Waste Management and Pollution Control Act 1998* (NT) (WMPC Act) (Section 48 Notice) and as amended pursuant to s 50 of the WMPC Act on 17 October 2022

TAKE NOTICE THAT I, Amy Dennison, Delegate of the Northern Territory Environment Protection Authority (NT EPA), in accordance with subsection 50(1) of the WMPC Act have determined to amend the environmental audit program in the Section 48 Notice dated 14 December 2021 as amended on 17 October 2022 for the following reasons:

1. Additional time has been required because the Draft Factual Report that was prepared in accordance with the requirements of the s.48 Notice identified data gaps, which required further investigation so that the Conceptual Site Model can be refined.
2. As a consequence, the preparation and review process for the audit report cannot be completed in the current timeframes.

For the above reasons, I have determined to make the following amendments to the Section 48 Notice dated 14 December 2021 as amended on 17 October 2022:

1. To delete requirement 10 of the Section 48 Notice and replace it with:
  10. By 24 August 2023, *Voyages Indigenous Tourism Australia Pty Ltd* (VITA) must submit the results of the program in the form of an Environmental Audit Report prepared by the person referred to in requirement 1 which must include, but not limited to:
    - (a) a summary of the methods used for sampling, classification and analysis;
    - (b) all soil and groundwater sample results and documentation;
    - (c) identification of all environmental risks relating to any identified contamination; and
    - (d) recommendations to prevent, rectify, clean up, rehabilitate or minimise potential environmental harm arising from any identified contamination.
