## NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

Environment Protection (Beverage Containers and Plastic Bags) Act 2011

- I, KATE WORDEN, Minister for Environment, Climate Change and Water Security, pursuant to section 49 (1) (a) of the *Environment Protection (Beverage Containers and Plastic Bags) Act 2011* ('the Act') establish targets for recycling of permitted containers under section 49 (2) (a) of the Act:
  - 1. The 'Stage 1' targets for recycling of permitted containers applying generally to all Container Deposit Scheme participants will be:
    - 60% recycling rate target for High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) permitted containers,
    - 70% recycling rate target for Liquid Paper Board (LPB) permitted containers,
    - 75% recycling rate target for Polyethylene Terephthalate (PET) permitted containers,
    - 90% recycling rate target for aluminium permitted containers, and
    - 95% recycling rate target for glass permitted containers.
  - 2. Stage 1 targets will commence on 1 July 2024, and will apply generally to all Container Deposit Scheme (CDS) participants meaning:
    - a. CDS coordinators and operators of a collection depot;
    - Manufacturers, distributors and beverage retailers of regulated containers (CDS suppliers);
    - c. Others carrying out activities relating to the collection, reuse, recycling or other appropriate disposal of regulated containers.

Stage 1 targets will be published on the NT EPA's website in accordance with section 49(1)(b) of the *Environment Protection (Beverage Containers and Plastic Bags) Act 2011.*
