Incident:	NT EPA report of oil leak from vessel Skye PRL13245

(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution	Reported oil leak from Skye
(b) the place where the incident occurred	Fisherman's Wharf
(c) the date and time of the incident	Around 11:50hrs - 5 August 2025
(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur	Vessel owner Les advised a small quantity of oil entered the harbour from his vessel's bilge whilst motoring back to Fisherman's Wharf
(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident	At 14:20hrs I inspected the water around Skye whilst tied up to Fisherman's Wharf, there was no sign of recoverable oil only a thin sheen on the surface. Vessel owner Les was onboard he advised 'they had already spoken to him' (Darwin Port pilot boat attended to investigate and clean up). Oil leak was minor and unsuitable to clean up with a spill kit therefore Les applied detergent to disperse any oil remaining.
