

Consultation and Communication Plan

1. Internal processes and procedures for consulting with major stakeholders when carrying out the licensed activity are as follow
 - a. **Communication between licensee and the clients** – Follow agreement reached strictly by collecting waste tyres that can be re-use and store them in a container.
 - b. **Cross contamination issues** – During the collection of the waste tyres, hand gloves and nose mask must be worn by the persons collecting and storing the waste tyres in a container.
 - c. **Collection timing** – Collection and storing of the waste tyres must be done during the tyre handler's working hours between 0800 and 1700 hours from Monday to Saturday.
 - d. **Communication with the disposal facility to ensure waste will be accepted, in time before closure, to avoid unlicensed storage of listed waste (overnight or otherwise) anticipating transport to the disposal facility** - We do not anticipate that because the shipping agent is responsible for transporting the containerized tyres from the waste tyre handler's yard to Darwin Port East Arm for export to Nigeria.
 - e. **Regular schedule/routine/agreement** - Prior to transportation from the tyre handler's yard, adequate arrangements had been made with the shipping agent with regards to accommodating the containerized tyres at the Darwin Port East Arm while undergoing documentation for export. This is part of the services quoted by the shipping agent and paid for by the licensee.
