Action that should be referred to NT EPA	Alterations to the Mt Todd Gold Project that have the potential to have a significant impact on the environment; or will result in new or additional areas being subject to a potential significant impact on the environment; including, but not limited to:
	 location and footprint of the waste rock dump:
	 to be increased in area by 28 ha beyond the previously assessed design
	 to be extended by 360 m to within approximately 1 km of the Edith River
	 to subsume the existing retention pond RP1.
	 location and footprint of new retention pond:
	 to have greater water storage capacity
	 that would reduce the distance between the river and mine affected water storage
	 changes to the water treatment plant
	 changes to power requirements and location of power station
	 expansion of the open pit envelope and associated alterations to drainage lines
	 clearing of additional potential Gouldian finch habitat, including breeding habitat (7.3 ha) and wet season foraging habitat (5.2 ha).
Decision	Request that the proponent refer the proposed action to the NT EPA under section 48 of the EP Act.
