I have been a resident of Alice Springs for over 40 years, and interested in and appreciative of the environment of Arid Australia. Low and erratic rainfall and the underlying geology make the region dependant of groundwater for life, and the health of ecosystems. So the removal of large volumes of water as proposed by the Singleton Horticultural Project is fraught with a Tier 3 level risk of causing damage to these ecosystems, especially considering the rising climatic temperatures, threating living conditions for all.
