

Response to Invitation to Comment – Manton Dam Return to Service Project

Dear Ms Fitzpatrick

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the referral received by the NT EPA under the *Environment Protection Act 2019* (NT) from Power and Water Corporation for the Manton Dam Return to Service Project.

The Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (the department) is yet to receive a referral for this proposal under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act). I note the referral to the NT EPA identifies the presence of EPBC-listed threatened species within the project footprint. Any proposal with the potential to have a significant impact on matters of national environmental significance, including EPBC-listed threatened species, must be referred to the department for consideration. I have written to Power and Water Corporation to inform them of this obligation.

Please be assured that I will advise you if the proposal is referred under the EPBC Act.
