<b>Incident:</b>	
<b>(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution</b>	<p>Leachate seepage detected on the eastern batter of stage 3 cell during the regular morning pump reading by Veolia. Approximately 15-20 l of leachate was released.</p> 
<b>(b) the place where the incident occurred</b>	Eastern batter of Stage 3 landfill cell, Shoal Bay.
<b>(c) the date and time of the incident</b>	16/01/2023 at 7.00 AM
<b>(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur</b>	A leachate seepage detected on the eastern batter of stage 3. This portion of the Stage 3 does not have engineered capping. There is still seepage occurring onsite. The situation is constantly monitored.

<p><b>(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident</b></p>	<p>The leachate seepage is contained in a soil bund in a drainage. The leachate will be collected using a mobile suction pump and transferred to the leachate ponds. The environmental harm from the incident is low and the incident is constantly monitored.</p> 
<p><b>(f) the identity of the person notifying the NT EPA</b></p>	<p>Pema Dorji/City of Darwin. Incident was notified to the Pollution Hotline at 12.12 pm on 16/01/2023</p>
