This submission is made under regulation 123 of the Environment Protection Regulations 2020

Summary:

- The Energy Titles branch have no additional comments to make from the submission on the referral.
- The Mineral Titles branch advise that the proposed Mandorah Marine Facilities may impact Exploration Licence (EL) 33303, held by NT Lithium Pty Ltd. Contact details are available on request.
- Fisheries branch advise that they have been in discussions with the Amateur Fishermen's Association of the Northern Territory (AFANT) regarding the use of the proposed breakwaters as land-based fishing platforms for recreational fishers.
