NT WorkSafe have no major comment to make on the Draft TOR.

It should be noted that this activity will fall under the Regulation of the NT *Work Health and Safety (National Uniform Legislation) Act 2011* and the *Dangerous Goods Act 1998* and their associated Regulations. These legislation covers both worker/other safety as a result of the activity and the installation works required for hydrogen (i.e. gas fitting requirements).

Depending on the size and the risk of the activity it may also require licensing under the Major Hazard Facility requirements under the WHS Act.

It appears that the TOR also incorporates area that NT WorkSafe also regulate so co-ordination and co-operation would be required to prevent different requirements from our Agencies.
