Date and Time of Notification:	12.06 pm Thursday the 3.3.2022
Person / Company:	City of Darwin
Incident:	Leachate went to ground while unloading a vac truck full of leachate.

(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution	Approximately 500 litres of leachate went to ground while decanting leachate into the storage pond.
(b) the place where the incident occurred	Southern Leachate Pond at Shoal Bay Landfill
(c) the date and time of the incident	11:30 am 3 rd of March 2022
(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur	While a Veolia truck was unloading Leachate into the southern pond collected from the groundwater interception point east of the leachate ponds. Leachate has escaped from the infeed portal to the pond.
(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident	<p>In the interim while we are managing excessive volumes of Leachate, all unloading will need to have an operator at the point of discharge who can act immediately in the event of a spill.</p> <p>Vacuum truck immediately started recovering spilt leachate off the ground. Veolia removed the contaminated soil and replaced it with clean material.</p>
