Incident:	Leachate Breakout on the western batter of stage 4.

(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution	Leachate outside the internal confines of stage 4 and running down the batter.
(b) the place where the incident occurred	Western batter just north of DW3.
(c) the date and time of the incident	7:30 am on the 21 st of March 2021
(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur	Leachate has penetrated the batter on stage 4 which has allowed leachate to run down the batter.
(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident	<p>A mechanical repair was tried using an excavator without any success due to the area being too wet. The area now has a temporary repair and bund to prevent leachate leaving site or entering the stormwater, this will be replaced with a more permanent bund either today or tomorrow.</p> <p>Veolia will then manage the leachate using a vac truck on site whereby the leachate will be transferred back to the leachate pond.</p>
