Details of Non-Compliance – Condition 19

When the non-compliance was detected and by whom:

October 2022 – Emma Fakes (Wastewater Quality Officer – Power and Water Corporation).

The date and time of the non-compliance:

The month of November 2021.

The actual and potential causes and contributing factors to the non-compliance:

Wastewater monitoring is conducted at the Ramingining authorised discharge point on a monthly basis as per licence condition 17 (monitoring must be conducted in accordance with Appendix 1).

1 monthly bacteriological sample has been missed during the reporting period (November 2021). The sampling contractor has submitted 1 of 2 wastewater samples for the month of November.

Power and Water have been transparent with the Department of Environment, Parks and Water Security (DEPWS) regarding the logistical issues present whilst conducting wastewater monitoring sites within remote Indigenous communities. Section 2.1 of the PWC Annual Monitoring Report for Remote Communities 2022 outlines transportation logistics and limitations identified for both drinking water and wastewater sampling in remote Indigenous areas including wet weather; community unrest; dangerous aquatic animals; remote transportation issues and contractor sampling errors. PWC endeavour to collect samples as per licence requirements where possible; PWC endeavour to collect the required number of samples per annum.
