

**Summary of Notification of Incident
- pursuant to Section 14 of the
Waste Management and Pollution Control Act**

Incident: Hydraulic Fluid Leak

THE IDENTITY OF THE PERSON NOTIFYING OF THE INCIDENT –

Roy Woodward

THE INCIDENT CAUSING OR THREATENING TO CAUSE POLLUTION –

A main hydraulic line to the tub of a Moxy dump truck burst while working on the causeway in Area 1A.

THE PLACE WHERE THE INCIDENT OCCURRED –

Blaydin Point

THE DATE AND TIME OF THE INCIDENT –

Night shift reported the incident at 5:32am. The length of the spill was approximately 30 meters and the duration of the spill was estimated to be less than a minute and probably less than half a minute.

HOW THE POLLUTION OCCURRED, IS OCCURRING OR MAY OCCUR –

During the night shift on 17/10/12, Moxy HV183 burst a hydraulic line while working on the causeway in Area 1A. A main hydraulic line to the tub of the Moxy dump truck bursts while performing a “dump and move” manoeuvre, causing the spill to be a significant amount spread over some distance.

THE ATTEMPTS MADE TO PREVENT, REDUCE, CONTROL, RECTIFY OR CLEAN UP THE POLLUTION OR RESULTANT ENVIRONMENTAL HARM CAUSED OR THREATENING TO BE CAUSED BY THE INCIDENT –

The spill kit was utilised and an earth bund pushed up to contain spill. The area was banded within the cut and barricaded off for inspection. The soil was scraped up and the contaminated soil volume is approximately 30m³ and stockpiled on geo-fabric (wrapped to contain from weather) in the contaminated waste area within the EMA. A waste transport company is collecting the last of wastes for appropriate disposal.
