

EMERGENCY SPILL MANAGEMENT PLAN

REPORT ALL SPILLS

STOP

1. Ensure that you and others are safe.
2. Secure the area. Evacuate non-essential personnel and restrict entry to the area

ASSESS

1. Assess the spill – Size? Substance? Vapours? Is it Hazardous? Is it moving?
2. Consult MSDS or Emergency Procedure Guide for chemical spills
3. Ensure the appropriate PPE is worn

CONTROL

1. Stop/control the spill at the source (if possible and is safe to do so)

CONTAIN & PREVENT

1. Contain the spill using Spill kits

CLEAN-UP

1. Clean the area:
2. Collect all equipment, contaminated materials and any other wastes.
3. Ensure waste and rubbish is disposed of correctly
