<b>Incident:</b>	Potential fire in VTG front lift solid waste collection truck containing general waste. Vehicle registration: CC59ZK

<b>(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution</b>	<p>Driver/operator of VTG front lift compactor truck smelt a burning smell after servicing customer site in Darwin City. Driver compacted load (in an effort to reduce oxygen and control incident) and contacted VTG Operations Manager and called emergency services.</p> <p>Emergency services (Fire Department Report 22008376 &amp; Police Department) directed driver to a safe location to discharge load for inspection at approx. 8:30AM. No naked flames were identified, smoke was coming from one specific part of the load only.</p>
<b>(b) the place where the incident occurred</b>	Fisherman's Place, Darwin City NT 0800 in front of Mr Barra.
<b>(c) the date and time of the incident</b>	24/06/2022 8:30AM
<b>(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur</b>	No pollution identified; VTG has not been able to identify the cause of the smoke.
<b>(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident</b>	<p>Fire brigade extinguished smoke. VTG delivered bulk waste bins to collect all waste and remediated area. As per page 2 photos.</p> <p>No uncontrolled discharge, listed waste, spillage or environmental harm was identified. No storm water drains nearby to unloaded area. No injuries or damage to equipment.</p>
