The following comments are provided by the Lands and Planning component of DIPL:

- The proposal is located on NT Portion 6823, Anindilyakwa.
- The area is unzoned land, however Overlay CNV (Clearing of Native Vegetation) applies to the land.
- As the site is located within Overlay CNV (Clearing of Native Vegetation), if an aggregate of 1ha of native vegetation is cleared (including past removal), development consent is required.
- Further information for a clearing of native vegetation application can be provided upon request, noting the application would be assessed by the Department of Environment, Parks and Water Security (DEPWS).

As it is acknowledged that this comment is provided past the cut-off date, this is simply for advice to the proponent. We have no formal issues to raise.
