Thank you for the opportunity to review and comment on the above.

NT WorkSafe previously commented on the project on 09 October 2023 and have no new issues to raise. It is noted that there will be significant hazardous chemicals being used on site including cyanide for gold processing.

As we have not heard anything from the proponent, I will be assuming that this project would trigger the requirements to hold a Major Hazard Facility Licence and as such the proponent will need to contact NT WorkSafe to discuss what is required.

Prior to any mining activity occurring the proponent **MUST** prepare and submit a certified Risk Management Plan covering this risk associated with the activity including any construction works.

This is a legislative requirement under Chapter 10 of the *NT Work Health and Safety (National Uniform Legislation) Act 2011*.

NT WorkSafe officers have no major environmental comment to make on the proposal currently without further discussion concentrating on hazardous chemical containment and its transport to and from the site, as well as storage on the site.

Worker (and others) safety will be regulated under the *NT Work Health and Safety (National Uniform Legislation) Act 2011* which contains significant requirements to help ensure worker safety and does include matters such as bunding requirement, spill control requirements etc.

Any explosives and LP Gases at the site will be regulated under the *Dangerous Goods Act 1998* and the transport of hazardous chemicals, to and from the site, will be regulated under the *Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road and Rail (National Uniform Legislation) Act 2010*.

The site will be inspected by NT WorkSafe during construction and ongoing through the Operational life of the project to ensure compliance with the legislation.
