(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution	Fire in a waste bin
(b) the place where the incident occurred	Adelaide River Waste Facility, Dorat Road, Adelaide River
(c) the date and time of the incident	Incident discovered 5.00pm Saturday and reported to Operations Supervisor via sms. Due to connectivity issues, Operations Supervisor did not receive message until Sunday 26 April 2020 at approximately 7.30am. Matter was reported immediately to Chief Executive Officer.
(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur	An unknown individual is setting fire to the waste bin. Chief Executive Officer has reported the incident to local Adelaide River Police. Awaiting receipt of a Promis No.
(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident	Fire was diminished when discovered by contractor. Refer attached image. Council is in the process of making improvements to security at the site.
