Incident:	Fire – Green Waste and Steel Area Adelaide River Waste Facility

(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution	Fire in green waste and steel area
(b) the place where the incident occurred	Adelaide River Waste Facility, Dorat Road, Adelaide River
(c) the date and time of the incident	Incident discovered 7.00am Monday 4 th May 2020 as facility was opened by contractor and reported to Operations Supervisor via sms. Matter was reported immediately to Chief Executive Officer.
(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur	An unknown individual is setting fire to green waste and the steel area. On this occasion the boundary fence has also damaged by a vehicle being driven through it. Chief Executive Officer reported the incident to local Adelaide River Police immediately – Promis Number: 9292767.
(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident	A contractor was contacted immediately to extinguish the fire on Monday 4 th May 2020. A further water cart was sent on Tuesday 5 th May 2020 as fire in green waste was still smouldering. Police regularly patrol the facility. Council is in the process of making improvements to security at the site.
