## Santos – Darwin Pipeline Duplication

Section of Referral	Theme or issue	Comment
Main SER - section 2.6	Flooding, cleaning, gauging and testing – hydrotesting of the pipeline prior to commissioning the pipeline and introducing hydrocarbons	• Petroleum Operations note that section 2.6 of the SER states that chemically treated water and mono ethylene glycol will be discharged in Commonwealth waters during the hydrotest process. While dispersion studies (refer section 8.5.2.4) predict that the discharge will not affect NT waters, Petroleum Operations request further information on the mechanism proposed during construction of the pipeline to monitor and confirm this.
