Thank you for the opportunity to review and comment on the above.
At this time NT WorkSafe officers have no major environmental comment to make on the proposal.

As the proposal is a Mine plus processing it is likely the plant will be a Major Hazard Facility and therefore required to be licensed. This is yet to be determined as no contact with NT WorkSafe has been made, as of yet.

Worker (and others) safety will be regulated under the *NT Work Health and Safety (National Uniform Legislation) Act 2011*.

Any explosives and LP Gases at the site will be regulated under the *Dangerous Goods Act 1998* and any transport of hazardous chemicals will be regulated under the *Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road and Rail (National Uniform Legislation) Act 2010*.

The site will be required to also submit a risk management plan (Certified) under chapter 10 of the WHS legislation. The site will be inspected by NT WorkSafe Officers during construction and then ongoing through the Operational life of the project.
