Good morning,

Please see below comments from the Parks and Wildlife Commission in relation to the Sweetwater Agricultural Development Stage 1.

Parks and Wildlife has no comments other than to note that further Stages 2 and 3 may have some impact on Parks Estates and consultation will be required to be undertaken with the Parks and Wildlife Commission at the time.

NT Parks is resolving access with the proponent and NT Land Corporation regarding access to the proposed Keep River National Park (Spirit Hills extension), potentially affected by Ord Stage 3. NT Parks seek to be included as a stakeholder with regard to future access to the proposed Park extension.

The upstream impact to aquatic biodiversity on Parks Estates due to irrigation flows from all three Stages into the Keep River is unknown and unable to be quantified at this time.
