(b) the place where the incident occurred	CNR OF EXPORT DRIVE AND BERRIMAH ROAD, EAST ARM
(c) the date and time of the incident	25/03/19 8.55 AM
(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur	CHLORINE COULD HAVE GOT INTO THE STORM WATER SYSTEM BUT DUE TO THE MINIMUM QUANTITY DIDN'T REACH THE SIDE OF THE ROAD BEFORE DRYING UP ON THE BITUMEN.
(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident	ALL DRUMS WERE REMOVED FROM ROAD WITHIN 5 MINUTES OF BEING DROPPED. NO LIQUID FLOW AS HEAT OF ROAD HELPED EVAPORATE THE LIQUID.
