

## SECTION 14 INCIDENT REPORT (*Waste Management and Pollution Control Act*)

<b>Date and Time of Notification:</b>	Monday 11 <sup>th</sup> May 2020 8.30am
<b>Person / Company:</b>	Anna Malgorzewicz Chief Executive Officer Coomalie Community Government Council
<b>Incident:</b>	Fire – Green Waste, Bulk Bins, General Waste Area Adelaide River Waste Facility

<b>(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution</b>	Fire in green waste, bulk bins, general waste area. Broken glass adjacent to bulk bins. Images attached.
<b>(b) the place where the incident occurred</b>	Adelaide River Waste Facility, Dorat Road, Adelaide River
<b>(c) the date and time of the incident</b>	Incident reported to Operations Supervisor at 6.18pm by council contractor following sighting of smoke from the Waste Facility. Smoke created from burning plastics. Matter was reported immediately to Chief Executive Officer. CEO in turn reported to local Adelaide River Police.
<b>(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur</b>	An unknown individual is setting fire to green waste and bulk bins. The damaged fence from the previous incident was repaired.
<b>(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident</b>	Council contractor who sighted smoke immediately brought a water cart to the Facility to extinguish the fire. A further water cart was sent on Monday 11 <sup>th</sup> May 2020 as fire in green waste was still smouldering.  Police regularly patrol the facility and are speaking with suspected parties this morning. Council is in the process of making improvements to security at the site.
