Good afternoon,

In relation to this Invitation to Comment, the Northern Territory Police, Fire and Emergency Services provides the below response:

- The remote location of the operation is outside of the Northern Territory Fire and Rescue Service (NTFRS) Emergency Response Area (ERA), which limits our ability to respond to an emergency in a timely manner;
- In regards to road crash/response, the NTFRS crews will respond as required within existing capacity as with any other crash. If the timeliness of that response does not adequately mitigate the risk for the Rustlers Roost and Quest 29 Open-Cut Mine Redevelopment, then self-funded measures should be implemented; and
- The NTFRS is happy to advise Primary Gold on current capabilities in the vicinity of their operations to inform their risk assessment.
