Having read the documents from Santos on their environmental statement, it is clear that the proposal to extend the Barossa mine and to build the pipeline to transport the gas is not in keeping with outcomes that need to be achieved not only in Australia but globally. Scope 3 emissions need to be considered as part Santos's contribution to a warming climate and Australia's responsibility, and indeed pledge, to a reduction in greenhouse gases.

The assessment must consider how:

1. To reduce carbon emissions when CCS is not viable at the moment and appears as 'greenwashing'
2. To protect an already diminishing environment for marine life in the port and around the neighbouring islands
3. To ensure that further mining and pipe construction will not diminish and degrade the landscape for generations to come

I am confident that the assessment panel will consider the many risks that Santos poses should they be given the green light to proceed with this project.
