

## **Maud Creek Oxide Project**

### Public Environmental Report

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT INVITED**

Katherine Mining NL proposes to develop a gold mine at Maud Creek, approximately 20 km from Katherine in the Northern Territory. The project involves the construction of a small open pit at Maud Creek and haulage of ore to the Union Reef Gold Mine for processing.

In accordance with the NT Environmental Assessment Act 1982, a Public Environmental Report, which describes the project proposal and its potential environmental effects, has been prepared. This document will be available for public review from Wednesday 5 April 2000 to Tuesday 18 April 2000. During this period it may be examined at the following locations:
