<b>Date and Time of Notification:</b>	25/03/22 5.09pm
<b>Person / Company:</b>	Emma Young / City of Darwin (EPL188-03)
<b>Incident:</b>	
<b>(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution</b>	Leachate spill of approximately 150l
<b>(b) the place where the incident occurred</b>	Northern leachate pond pipe area, Shoal Bay Waste Management Facility
<b>(c) the date and time of the incident</b>	25/03/22 Approximately 4pm
<b>(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur</b>	A backflow incident when the operators vacuum truck was transferring leachate to the northern leachate pond
<b>(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident</b>	Spill was contained immediately. Absorption pads were initially put down. Soil was used to soak up the liquid that was spilled. The leachate contaminated soil was then scrapped up and placed into a contained storage bin.
<b>(f) the identity of the person notifying the NT EPA</b>	Emma Young/City of Darwin. Incident was notified to the Pollution Hotline at 4.45pm 25/03/22
