Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above proposal.
NT WorkSafe have no major environmental comment to make at this time.

We do note that this is a farming proposal with matters such as hazardous chemicals, fuels and traffic management some of the matters that will need to be considered in an operation of this scale. These would be operational issues to be considered in future assessments and project procedures and is expected to have little effect on the initial project proposal. As there is a large tract of land to be cleared dust may be an issue during the dryer months of the year and risk associated with dust exposure will need to be considered and eliminated where possible. The project once commenced will also fall under the NT *Work Health and Safety (National Uniform Legislation) Act 2011* and may be visited by officers at any time.
