(c) the date and time of the incident	13 th March 2026 10:15am
(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur	The dam has a spillway designed to stop water from coming into contact with the wall of the dam. Due to the highest rainfall we have recorded the dam is now full to the height of the spillway. The driving factor is that water going out to the environment is a lessor risk to the environment then a catastrophic failure of the dam wall. After consultation with the NT Mines Department, we have agreed that the temporary plug across the spillway will be removed and excess water will now flow out of the dam into Horseshoe Creek. We anticipate that water will continue to flow (at varying rates driven by various rainfall events) until the water level drops below the spillway height.
(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident	We are continuing to pump from RP7 to RP3 (Batman Pit) at the maximum rate of the pumping infrastructure (~125 l/sec). We will take daily water samples of this water (RP7), water before the mine (SW2), and after the mine (SW4 or SW10). We will also sample downstream of where this water enters Horseshoe Creek (SW11). The data will be used by an expert to produce a report specifically focused on if any effect on the environment can be measured. Our initial assessment is that no harm will be caused as the receiving environment is in a flood state.
