

## SECTION 14 INCIDENT REPORT (*Waste Management and Pollution Control Act*)

<b>Date and Time of Notification:</b>	Monday 4 September 2017 at 8.29am
<b>Person / Company:</b>	Rishenda Moss – City of Palmerston
<b>Incident:</b>	Underground fire – old landfill site at Archer Waste Transfer Station Lot 4302.

<b>(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution</b>	Underground fire – old landfill site at Archer – Lot 4302.
<b>(b) the place where the incident occurred</b>	Lot 4302
<b>(c) the date and time of the incident</b>	First came to the attention of Council at 8.29am 4 <sup>th</sup> September 2017.
<b>(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur</b>	At this stage it is unknown how the fire has started. Preliminary investigations are underway by Council in relation to recent prescribed burns and any other activities that may have occurred recently in the vicinity.
<b>(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident</b>	We have deployed contractors to block any access from the public to the site. Arranging to have a perimeter trench dug and water trucks deployed to drench the area.
<b>(f) the identity of the person notifying the NT EPA</b>	Rishenda Moss Environment and Emergency Operations Officer
