(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution	An excavator has broken down on tidal flats adjacent to Maningrida barge ramp. It has become inundated by high tides and the excavator still has fuel inside it. The excavator will need to be removed by a crane, and this will 1-2 weeks to organise a removal.
(b) the place where the incident occurred	Maningrida barge ramp
(c) the date and time of the incident	15/02/2020 was the time of first inundation of the excavator (only inundated at high tides).
(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur	<p>As the excavator still has fuel in it, it is possible fuel may leak into seawater.</p> <p>UPDATE: ALL FUEL AND OIL WAS SIPHONED FROM EXCAVATOR ON 17/02/2020</p>
(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident	<p>The excavator fuel is getting siphoned out on 17/02/2020 to remove this pollution hazard.</p> <p>UPDATE: COMPLETED</p>
