Main Report – section 7.4	Workforce accommodation	<p>It is acknowledged the Referral commits to maximising local opportunities through an Indigenous Participation Plan, in addition to expected contractual requirements relating to Indigenous participation, and the Referral provides limited information on the number of workers requiring temporary accommodation in the camps within the gravel pit site compound.</p> <p>CM&amp;C suggests whilst estimates of workforce numbers are not known, a possible range indicating the lowest and highest likely scenarios of local workforce could be provided and refined as estimates became more accurate to inform more detailed consideration of potential workforce accommodation requirements.</p>
Main Report – section 7.5	Stakeholder consultation	<p>The Referral includes a summary of the consultation conducted, a brief consultation strategy and refers to certain key stakeholders, however lacks a breakdown of identified project stakeholders.</p> <p>The Referral would benefit from the inclusion of a breakdown of project stakeholders to support the development of the detailed consultation strategy.</p>
