Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above project.

There have been significant changes to the original project scope. Especially with the addition of processing including the ammonia plant, sulphuric acid plant and the phosphoric acid plant and the storage of sulphur and fertiliser and bulk chemical storage tanks.

Based on the information provided this site will most likely be determined as a Major Hazard Facility requiring it to produce a Safety Case and hold a Major Hazard Facility Licence before storage of any hazardous chemicals above threshold would be permitted. This has been recognised on page Xv *“there are appropriate actions and processes in place to ensure they will be fully addressed and managed as part of the MHF licencing process”*

The proponent has not provided much information to NT WorkSafe.

NT WorkSafe will consider this project in more detail as part of their consideration for Major Hazard Facility determination and process as the proponent provides further detail.
