## Submission on the referral

## Groote Eylandt Mining Company Ltd - Southern Lease Exploration Project

This submission is made under regulation 53 of the Environment Protection Regulations 2020

Government authority: Department of Industry, Tourism and Trade (DITT)

## Summary:

DITT has reviewed the Southern Lease Exploration Project Referral and considers that GEMCO has demonstrated considerable knowledge of the project area. Whilst the proposed works involve significant disturbance (62.7 ha), some of this disturbance will occur in previously disturbed areas and appropriate mitigation strategies are described. Strategies such as pre-clearance surveys, exclusion of ecologically and culturally sensitive areas and progressive rehabilitation will ensure that the environmental risks will be adequately managed and consequently the proposal presents a low environmental risk. DITT considers that the Southern Leases Exploration Project identifies and addresses NT EPA environmental factors.
