Incident:	Bush Fire
(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution	Bush Fire
(b) the place where the incident occurred	Bush fire originating from off-site location burned in a northerly direction towards the Archer Waste Transfer Station. The location of the fire on the premise included the site perimeter. Additionally, a small section of one mulch pile was ignited by embers and action immediately commenced to extinguish. Mulch pile fire was successfully extinguished.
(c) the date and time of the incident	8 May 2022 at 11:30am
(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur	Observations made in regard to smoke direction and dispersion was that the smoke blew in a north westerly direction and dispersed.
(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident	NT Fire and Rescue service called and took action to extinguish the bush fire. Action taken by Veolia to extinguish the fire ignited in the mulch pile. Both fires successfully extinguished.
