Re: Environment Protection Licence (EPL 317) – Annual Monitoring Report

I am writing to you regarding Conditions 56 and 57 of the Project Sea Dragon (PSD) Environment Protection Licence (EPL 317) for the Core Breeding Centre, Broodstock Maturation Centre and Hatchery (the Project).

Condition 56 requires the submission of a Monitoring Report to the administering agency within 10 business days after each anniversary date of the EPL (i.e. prior to 25 March), and Condition 57 specifies the information to be included in the Monitoring Report.

Monitoring activities associated with the scheduled activity (i.e. discharge of wastewater from the Project) are yet to commence, as no operational discharges have occurred to date. As such, a Monitoring Report as described in Condition 56 and 57 has not been prepared.
