

## **Emergency Response Plan**

### **Objectives of the Emergency Response Plan**

1. Minimize adverse effects on the tyre handler's employee, general public, damage to property or harm to the environment during an emergency
2. Facilitate a rapid and effective response and recovery from tyre incident
3. Provide assistance to emergency services
4. Communicate vital information to relevant persons-both internal and external

### **The following emergency situation might happen at the tyre handlers yard and when transporting the waste tyres:**

1. Containerized tyres becoming unsecure during transport
2. Fire in tyre handlers yard/when transporting waste tyres
3. If the facility where the tyres are being transporting to decide to no longer accept or accommodate the waste tyres
4. Vehicle accident while transporting the containerized tyres

### **Measures that are in place for responding to these emergency situation**

1. **Containerized tyres becoming unsecure during transport** – the driver must take the following steps
  - a. Get the vehicle off the road, switch on four way flashers. If not fitted, switch on park and clearance lights.
  - b. Stop the engine and switch off ignition.
  - c. Place warning triangles (double sided) as required by law (50-150 m to the front and rear and one alongside vehicle).
  - d. Investigate unsecure containerized tyres and notify Management on mobile number 0469012343 (Olawale Bolaji), 0434474991 (Risikat Bolaji) and 0469780051 (Wunmi Bolaji).
  - e. Notify Police and Emergency Services
  - f. If instructed to do so by the management based on current situation, driver should secure the containerized tyres. Otherwise, driver must take all precautions to reduce risk of accident that might result from the unsecure containerized tyres and arrange for the vehicle to be towed to a safe area to secure the containerized tyres.
2. **Fire in tyre handlers yard/when transporting waste tyres** – Remember that there are three elements creating a fire; Oxygen, Fuel and Heat/Ignition. So, as a team, the employee at the tyre handlers yard must take the following steps
  - a. Shut OFF all the emergency fuel pump switches and pier electrical breakers.
  - b. Remove any persons away from the fire and account for all persons.
  - c. Dial “000” to notify Police, Ambulance and Fire department
  - d. Call management on mobile number 0469012343 (Olawale Bolaji), 0434474991 (Risikat Bolaji) and 0469780051 (Wunmi Bolaji).
  - e. Remove all movable items away from the fire area, only if safely possible.

- f. If you are qualified and you are absolutely sure that no explosive materials are involved in the case of small fire, use the fire extinguisher found at sight and available away from the fire to put out the fire.
  - g. In the case of fire when transporting the waste tyres, the driver must get vehicle off the road, stop the engine and switch off the ignition. The driver will then immediately take emergency measure in 2c, 2d, 2e and 2f above.
3. **If the facility where the tyres are being transporting to decide to no longer accept or accommodate the waste tyres** – We do not anticipate that because
- a. The shipping agent is responsible for transporting the containerized tyres from the waste tyre handler’s yard to Darwin Port East Arm for export to Nigeria.
  - b. Prior to transportation from the tyre handler’s yard, adequate arrangements had been made with the shipping agent with regards to accommodating the containerized tyres at the Darwin Port East Arm while undergoing documentation for export. This is part of the services quoted by the shipping agent and paid for by the licensee. 4. **Vehicle accident while transporting the containerized tyres** - the driver must take the following steps
- a. Stop the engine and switch off ignition.
  - b. Switch off all lights (including flashers) and disconnect batteries (isolate switch if fitted).
  - c. Do everything possible to secure the accident scene and prevent other traffic from becoming involved.
  - d. Notify Police and Emergency services.
  - e. Move any injured persons to the upwind side of the accident scene.
  - f. Clear the road as much as possible but avoid contact with fire, fuel and smoking persons with the containerized tyres.
