(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution	Loss of Expandol to ground

(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur	Investigation underway, suspect siphoning effect, post deluge testing with potable water.
(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident	The impoundment pond was isolated to prevent pump out. The contents of the impoundment pond was removed and the impoundment pond cleaned. These wastewaters have been securely stored and will be taken from site by a licensed contractor for licensed disposal. The storage tank has been isolated and tagged to prevent reinstatement. All deluge testing at this location has been suspended. Soil removal in the affected area is continuing. The area has been covered to prevent rain ingress.
