<b>Incident:</b>	Fire on Stage 6 – C&D waste disposal area
<b>(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution</b>	<p>A potential battery-related fire recorded on Stage 6 where some C&amp;D waste caught fire.</p> 
<b>(b) the place where the incident occurred</b>	Stage 6 – C&D waste disposal area
<b>(c) the date and time of the incident</b>	30/06/2025 at 6 am
<b>(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur</b>	A potential battery-related fire incident recorded on Stage 6 where C&D waste is currently disposed. The fire has been extinguished, and it is under constant monitoring.
<b>(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident</b>	<p>The fire has been extinguished using soil to smother the flames and water truck used to extinguish the smaller spot fires in the grass areas. The area is constantly being monitored.</p>
