Incident:	Small fire, Humpty Doo Waste Transfer Station

(a) the incident causing or threatening to cause pollution	Small fire in the back of a customers vehicle.
(b) the place where the incident occurred	Humpty Doo Waste Transfer Station 225 Strangways Rd, Humpty Doo, road into Waste Transfer Station.
(c) the date and time of the incident	23/07/2025 at 14:23
(d) how the pollution has occurred, is occurring or may occur	Customer drove into Waste transfer station, unaware that rubbish in the back of their vehicle had caught fire. Fire was quickly extinguished by Litchfield council staff before pollution could occur.
(e) the attempts made to prevent, reduce, control, rectify or clean up the pollution or resultant environmental harm caused or threatening to be caused by the incident	Fire was promptly put out by staff by 14:30. The burnt cardboard was soaked with water and safely disposed of.
