RESOLUTION 2022/06/21/018 That Council;

a) includes the following matters/issues/opportunities/concerns in its submission on the Australia-Asia Powerlink (Sun Cable) EIS - Lack of knowledge in the community regarding the project; - Lack of knowledge on the potential effects on human health, livestock and the environment; - Physical barrier risks to aircraft, medical aircraft and plant; - Risk mitigation measures regarding system failure and damage on community health and environmental safety; - Concerns regarding EMF (electro magnetic fields); and Impacts on nesting raptors; and

b) directs the Chief Executive Officer to lodge a formal submission with the NT EPA by the due date of 15th July 2022. Moved: Clr. Freeman Seconded: Clr. Noble Carried Council welcomes a further opportunity to discuss the project with the proponents.
