Main report – section 3.3	Economic	The proponent notes employment opportunities as a result of project activities and related positive impacts to the local economy. CM&C suggests the proponent includes a commitment to prioritising local employment and local procurement, where possible, to ensure that local economic benefits are maximised.
Main report – section 5.8	AAPA certificate	CM&C notes the proponent has already acquired an Abstract of Records from AAPA, and will obtain an updated record. It is recommended an AAPA Authority Certificate also be obtained for the project area.
Main report – section 5.10	Consultation with Traditional Owners	It is unclear whether the Native Title holders of the area, the Warranangku people, are being consulted. CM&C recommends consultation be undertaken with the traditional owners of the project area.
Main report – section 5.8	Stakeholder Engagement	The proponent has committed to stakeholder engagement, however, a list of stakeholders should be provided.
