



darwin city waterfront – a major CBD redevelopment

The Northern Territory Government proposes to develop 25 hectares of land and adjoining water in the CBD area of Darwin. The redevelopment will include a convention and exhibition centre along with other commercial, residential and tourism development.

In accordance with the provision of the *Northern Territory Environmental Assessment Act* a Draft Environmental Impact Statement which describes the project and the potential environmental impacts has been prepared by URS Pty Ltd, on behalf of the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Environment. The Proponent has been directed under the Act to advertise the proposal and make available the draft EIS, for public comment for a period of six weeks from Saturday 29th May to Monday 12th July 2004.

The EIS will be available for public review at the following locations during this period:
